Thomas Cook-owned IKYA Group buys Canadian firm Brainhunter

Mumbai: Thomas Cook (India) Ltd-owned staffing company IKYA Group has signed an agreement to acquire Canadian **Brainhunter Companies Llc**, owned by **Zylog Systems (Canada) Ltd**.

The acquisition will allow IKYA access to the information technology (IT) staffing business in North America, the company said in a filing to BSE on Thursday. Brainhunter, an IT and engineering professional firm, employs around 700 and has revenues of about \$80 million, IKYA said in the filing. IKYA did not disclose the value of the deal.

The Bangalore-based IKYA Group has interests in HR services, IT services, engineering services and facility management services.
