The Andhra Pradesh Economic Development Board (APEDB) on Friday signed a MoU with Quess Corp to establish a skills university. The MoU was signed and exchanged between APEDB CEO J. Krishna Kishore, and Quesscorp Pvt Ltd CEO, Subrata Nag.

The planned University is expected create employment opportunities in the state. The partnership looks to create an education model which can deliver technical and vocational learning in various domains.

sectors. The proposed Skills University by Quess shall have short-term programs under one year duration aligned with the identified thrust sectors of the state as per the AP Vision 2029. The Skills university shall provide over 900 direct employment and over 600 employment indirectly. The university will initially begin with an intake of 1,500 students per annum with a planned increased capacity to 5,000 in future".
